Group Size: Maximum 8 candidates

Who should attend:

- c) Selected candidates who will be required to Supervise traffic management on High-Speed Dual Carriageways.
- d) Candidates who require completing of this programme as part of their achievement to become a Traffic Safety Control Officer (TSCO)

The aim of this course: is to provide candidates with the necessary knowledge to enable them to supervise the installation, removal of static temporary traffic management measures on high-speed dual carriageway.

Course Objectives:

Upon completion of the course the Learner will be able to:

- Plan traffic management layout required to allow access to work area.
- Calculate the distances required for a range of traffic management layouts.
- Calculate the amount of equipment required for a given traffic management layout.
- Assess the standard of equipment that is acceptable to use.
- Have an understanding the planning required for relaxation or standard works.
- Have an understanding the different types of temporary markings and how is incorporated within standard works.
- Have an understanding of how temporary hard shoulder running can be used in conjunction with relaxed or standard works.
- Have an understanding how mandatory temporary speed limits affect the traffic management layout.
- Have an understanding of the systems for switching traffic between lanes and contra flow conditions.

- c) Registered 12a Foreman will receive a Foreman registration card valid for 5 years.
- d) Candidates who are not registered as operatives will receive a certificate which is valid for 2 years.
