

## National Highways Sector Scheme 12b Lead Traffic Management Operative (LTMO)

**Duration:** 2 days

**Group Size:** Maximum 8 candidates

## Who should attend:

- a) Selected candidates who will be required to work on High-Speed Dual Carriageways as a Lead Traffic Management Operative (LTMO)
- b) Candidates who require completing of this programme as part of their achievement to become a Traffic Management 12a Foreman (TMF) and Traffic Safety Control Officer (TSCO)

**The aim of this course:** is to provide candidates with the necessary knowledge to enable them to supervise the installation, removal of static temporary traffic management measures on high-speed dual carriageway.

## **Course Objectives:**

Upon completion of the course the Learner will be able to:

- Be able to plan the traffic management layout required to allow access a given work area
- Be able to understand the distances required to install a range of temporary traffic management layouts
- Be able to assess the standard and quality of equipment that is acceptable to use
- Have an understanding of the planning required for works with relaxations
- Have an understanding of How different works with relaxations are constructed
- Have an understanding of How temporary hard shoulder running can be used in conjunction with works with relaxations.

## • Certification/Registration:

- a) Registered 12b LTMO will receive a LTMO registration card valid for 5 years.
- b) Candidates who are not registered as 12a/b operatives will receive a certificate which is valid for 2 years.
